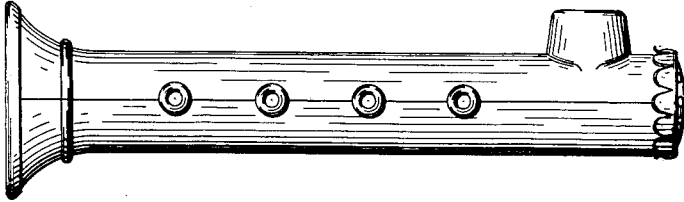

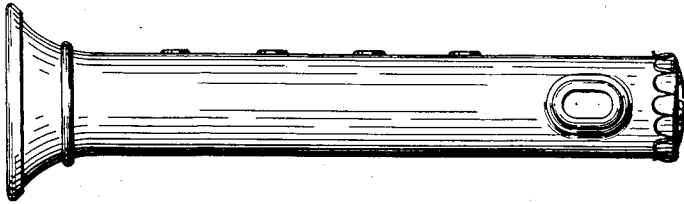

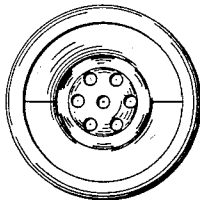

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert D. Peebles, a citizen of the United States and residing at Waterbury, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Humming Musical Instruments, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing.
