

DESIGN FOR A MUSICAL WIND INSTRUMENT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James Ross Gillie, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Musical Wind Instrument, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the musical wind instrument, showing my design;

Fig. 2 is a side perspective view; and Fig. 3 is an end elevational view thereof. I claim:
