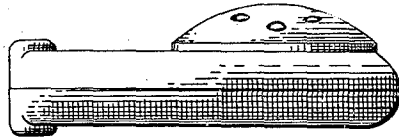

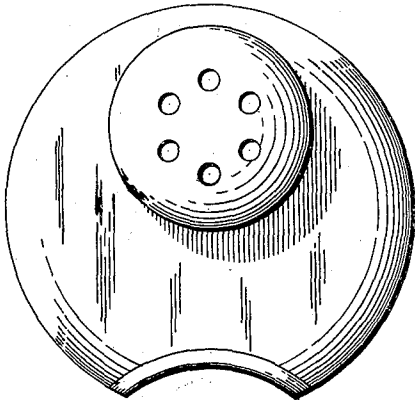

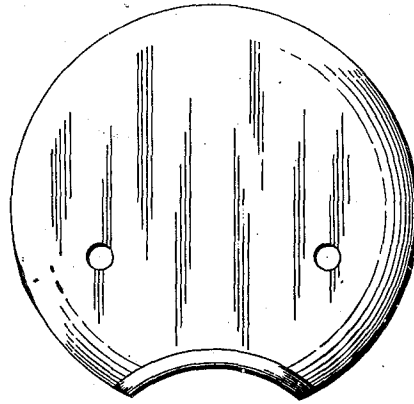

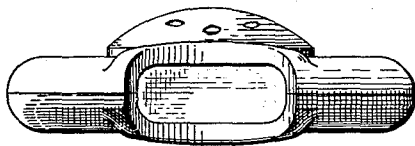

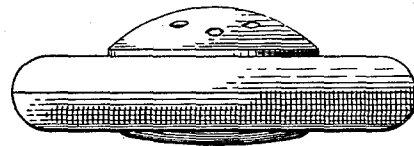

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Josephus Thompson, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Covington, county of Miami, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Kazoo, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a kazoo showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan view thereof;
Figure 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
Figure 4 is a front end view thereof; and
Figure 5 is a rear end view thereof.
