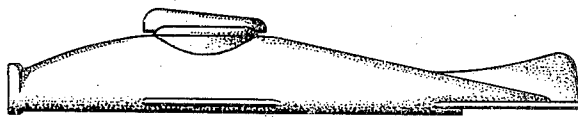

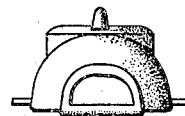

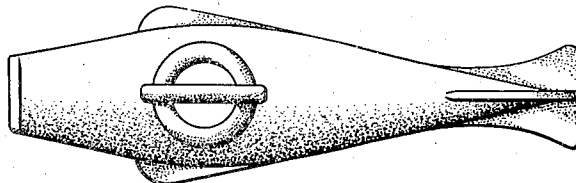
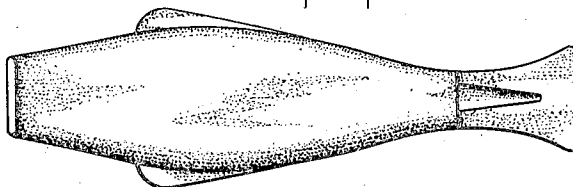

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David John Ferrier, a subject of the King of Great Britain, residing at 23 Monkstadt Avenue, St. Kilda, in the State of Victoria, Commonwealth of Australia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Kazoo, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a kazoo showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a front elevation,

Fig. 3 is a plan view, and

Fig. 4 is an underneath plan view thereof.

The ornamental design for a kazoo, substantially as shown.
